Editor's Note

The book contains the names and basic data of the Leaders and members of Baloch Students Organization Azad who have been martyred by the Pakistani secret agencies and army for practicing their right to politics and struggle for a liberated and sovereign Balochistan. The leadership of BSO Azad has been constantly facing the state repression for the struggle of Balochistan's liberation movement. Many workers were abducted and, later on, their dead bodies, marking the signs of extreme torture, were found in different parts of Balochistan. Plenty of them were killed in fake encounters by Pakistani army, while some others were martyred through target killings. Multifold members, including the leadership of BSO Azad, are still in the dungeons of the secret agencies facing the worst kind of tortures for exercising peaceful political struggle. BSO Azad pays the richest tribute to the martyrs of the Baloch liberation movement and will continue their mission of Independence of Balochistan till victory.

BANUK KARIMA BALOCH

BANUK KARIMA BALOCH

Chairperson of BSO AZAD

Banuk Karima Baloch was born on March 8, 1983, in Dubai and lived her childhood there. After 5 to 6 years, she returned to Balochistan. She completed her early education at Tump Girls High School and did her intermediate (FSC) from Tump Inter College. After that, she accomplished her graduation from Government Girls Degree College Turbat.

Karima Baloch started her journey as a political worker from the platform of BSO Azad in 2005 when she was a student. Karima, with her dedication, commitment, and hard work, was soon elected as the Central Committee member in 2006's Council Session of BSO Azad. She was later elected as the Central Junior Vice-Chairperson of the organization in the 2008's Council Session. After the Council Session of 2008, the leadership of BSO Azad was under the target of the State. Several members and leadership of the organization were targeted, killed and enforcedly disappeared including the

Vice-Chairperson of the organization Zakir Majeed. Under the given circumstances, it was not possible to continue student activism on surface but Karima did not refrain and took the responsibilities on her shoulders. She, under such crucial times, continued the Organizational activities along with other leaders of BSO Azad who survived. In effect to the situation, many activists of the Organization went in exile abroad. However, Karima was not in favor of going exile, but was continuing the Organizational activities on the ground. Hence, she continued the Organizational activities and was elected as the Senior Vice-Chairperson in the 2012's Council Session. After the mentioned Session, Chairperson of the Organization, Zahid Baloch was forcibly disappeared by the security agencies in front of Karima Baloch. After that, Karima Baloch led the hunger strike till death by a CC member of the Organization. She also led the Organization as the Senior Vice-Chairperson of the Organization.

Karima was elected as Chairperson of the Organization in the Council Session of 2015. Thus, after one year as the Chairperson, she

went to Canada. But from there, she continued to manage the Organizational activities and led the Organizational matters. She was titled as Lumma-e-Watan (Mother of Nation) on her martyrdom by BSO Azad. Apart from this, the Organization declared 21 December as the “Baloch Women Day” which is the day when the State deprived Baloch nation of their leader, Karima Baloch. She also had the honor to bring change in the life of common women in the society. Even after Karima, thousands of Baloch women openly joined the Baloch struggle for the freedom. She was martyred by the Pakistani Intelligence agencies on 22 December, 2020, in Canada. Banuk Karima is an Era of struggle, devotion, sacrifice and commitment. Due to her extraordinary struggle, she received the appellation of honor as “Lumma” – Mother – by Baloch people.

Comrade Qayyum was born on 3rd November, 1984 in Shay Nizar Mohammad's home at Gwadar. He studied at Jaded School in Gwadar in 1989 and continued to study there until he passed his matric exam in 2002. Further, he did his intermediate degree in Sayad Hashumi Degree College in his hometown in 2004. Later, Qayyum Baloch did his bachelors as a private candidate in 2008. He was a decent and industrious learner and was entitled to be a hardworking and well-learned comrade of BSO Azad. He was attributed to have a keen interest in political literature.

Comrade Qayyum, a sincere personality, joined BSO Azad at a very young age of his life like many other Baloch youth did because of the Organizational program and activities. Joining BSO Azad endured him to be a companion of senior activists and this opportunity displayed in from of significant activism thereof. His matured

political activities and circles, revolving around educational titles in declaration narrating BSO, is not just frivolous pastime but a national and, indeed, a duty of every Baloch who undoubtedly wants the Pakistani subjugation to end. Due to his commitment and political maturity, he was elected as the Central Committee member of BSO Azad.

Soon after, he became one of the important figures in politics, particularly in Kech district of Makuran. He had become so active that the enemy soon recognised him. He was first arrested by police personnel on 11 December, 2008 for arranging a demonstration on the first martyrdom anniversary of Balach Marri. He was kept in a secret cell for 61 days and threatened to stop the struggle for the freedom of Balochistan, but he was too devoted and took the hard decision of the journey of revolution.

Comrade Qayyum had two children, a boy named Hairbyar and a daughter named Shefa. He was a great, dynamic activist and leader of BSO Azad. Seeing his unwavering obligations

and enthusiasm, Pakistan tried to silence him forever. On 11 September 2010, he was allegedly abducted by the intelligence agencies from his uncle's house at Gwadar. Two months later on 10 February 2011, his severely mutilated body was recovered along with Jameel Yaqoob Baloch in Herronk, Kech District. Suppression, intimidation, disappearances and kill and dump could not succeed over the firm vision and wisdom of Comrade Qayyum Baloch, which is still sustained in the sentiments of Baloch youth.

RAZA JAHANGEER BALOCH

Secretary General of BSO AZAD

Raza Jahangeer was born on December 1, 1987, at Tertaj village of Awaran in the house of martyred Bakhtiyar Baloch – targeted by Pakistani squad for belonging to a political family. He acquired his primary education from Primary School Tertaj. He did his matric from Modal High School Awaran in 2004. Being an avid reader of Balochi books and magazines, he had been soon entwined with Balochi literature. Soon after, he became a Balochi poet and writer. As in touch with literature, he staged his second name as “Jahangeer”.

To further continue his higher studies, he went to Shaal (Quetta) and sought admission at Government Poly Technique College Quetta as electrical sub-engineering. It was the time when BSO Azad strived to come out of the parliamentary politics and started campaigning for the freedom of Balochistan under the umbrella of BSO Mutthaheda. Raza Jahangeer, a

forever devotee of his motherland, soon joined BSO Mutthahida. After joining BSO, Raza focused on national issues and soon became the Information secretary of BSO Azad Awaran Zone. He had later become the president of Awaran zone. During his zonal presidency tenure, he functionalised BSO Azad Awaran Zone, where a number of youth got inspired by him and joined the national struggle on the platform of BSO Azad. Thereafter, he was recognised as a key figure in the Organization.

Besides this, he also gave a private exam of B.A during that period. In the same way, due to his commitment and intelligence, Raza Jahangeer was elected as a Central Committee member of BSO Azad in the Council Session of 2008. With the same token, his contributions and tireless efforts led him to become the General Secretary of BSO Azad in the 19th Council Session. He was arrested during a raid by police after Raza along with his friend's held demonstrations against the abduction of Central Vice Chairman Sangat Zakir Majeed. Too many FIRS were filed against him for his struggle for

the national cause. Lastly, Raza Jahangeer was martyred along with Imdad Bojair in Apsar Turbat on 14th of August, 2013, during a military raid by the Pakistani forces in the house of Imdad Bojair. His commitment and devotion to the Baloch cause were always remarkable and his struggle shall continue until the freedom of Balochistan.

Shakoor Baloch was born on 23rd August, 1988, in the fertile land of Mastung. He belonged to the Dehwar tribe of the Baloch nation. Shakoor Baloch did his primary and secondary education from his native town. After doing intermediate, he further decided to precede his higher education from Quetta where he joined BSO Azad. Shakoor Baloch was highly devoted to the national cause that in a very young age, he embraced martyrdom for his motherland. In the initial phases of his political career, he was elected as Deputy and Unit Secretary of University of Balochistan (UOB)'s unit. After gaining political maturity and understanding, he was elected as a Central Committee Member of BSO Azad in 2012's council session.

Moreover, Shakoor was a dedicated and committed activist of the Organization. Besides his educational career, he devoted his entire life

to political purposes. To afford his educational expenses, he became a parttime teacher in a language Centre to continue his studies and politics contemporarily. He was a potential learner and his personality remained inspiring and effective among the Baloch Students. Shakoor was intensively a simple person with flexible behavior, unverbose nature and human loving character. His style of communicating with friends and people around him was appraised and he was a keen observer. Behind his unverbose nature, he had concealed the future of the Baloch nation.

Shakoor was martyred by the security forces of Pakistan on the 18th of August, 2013, in Saryab road nearby Balochistan University in front Of Barma Hotel. This was a huge loss for all the Baloch nation and particularly for the Organization for which he had been a keen Central Committee Member. Unfortunately, his mother and father were also tortured and beaten by the security agencies on the same day as they

went to receive the dead body of the great and devoted son of the Baloch soil.

Qambar Chakar was born on October 7, 1987, at Alandoor in Buleda. His family migrated to Shahi Tump Turbat of District Kech. After acquiring primary education in his native area Alandoor, Qambar Chakar got admission at Government Atta Shad Degree College Turbat. For further education, he went to Quetta where he managed to seek admission at the prestigious Balochistan University of Information, Technology and Management Sciences (BUIITMS) as a BS Economics student after passing a very competitive exam.

Along with continuing his studies as a student at BUIITMS, he also became active in student politics and worked hard to spread the awareness of Baloch nationalism among Baloch students. In this regard, he launched the first unit of BSO AZAD in BUIITMS. Many of the students, after being inspired by Qambar Chakar, joined the journey of BSO Azad which was boarding clearly on the Independent Balochistan.

Qambar was a vocal person for the missing persons too, as he had been mostly engaged with the foreign journalists as he was proficient in English language. Qambar was an extraordinary leader of the student organization. Whenever he got the mic, none could speak better than him on stage. When he held the pen, he wrote efficiently than anyone could ever. Further, he was a committed and courageous worker of BSO Azad. He even joined weekly study circles in injured conditions. He remained punctual in Organizational activities.

In a very short period, Qambar became an exceptional leader among Baloch students due to his struggle for the students' rights and independence. He very soon became a leading figure among Baloch youth when he campaigned for the rights of Balochistan in his institution BUITMS. Firstly, Qambar was whisked away by the security forces in 2009 when he had gone to the Takato Campus of the University to meet with the Vice-Chancellor on the issues of open merit admission policy. After being released, he confirmed that he had been brutally tortured during the custody for being active for the rights

of Baloch students as well as raising his voice for the Baloch Missing Persons. He was once again whisked away from his home at ShahiTump (Turbat) along with his cousin on November 26, 2010. The bullet-riddled dead body of Qambar Chakar, along with Ilyas Nizar Baloch, was found in a desolate place near Pasni Road, Pidrak area of Turbat on 5th of January, 2011.

Senior Joint Secretary of BSO AZAD

Shafi Baloch, son of Mohammad Alam, was a resident of district Sibbi. He was a student of B.A in Degree Collage Sibbi and Central Senior Joint Secretary of BSO Azad. He was also a patient of kidney. He was on his way from Quetta to Mastung with some activists of BSO Azad when their vehicle was intercepted by three white vehicles at Lakh Pass and armed men dragged all the passengers out. They took Shafi Baloch into custody including his 14 other friends on 17th June, 2011. After 6 days of extreme torture and psychological violence, his mutilated dead body was found from Bolan area of Mach on 23rd of June, 2011, with sign of extreme torture by the security agencies.

He was a keen lover of books and studied the nationalist literature most of the time. He was among the top leadership of the Baloch Students Organization Azad when the Organization was in the radar of the Pakistani brutalities and their

activists were being killed on daily basis. Shafi's dumped body was the continual policy of the Pakistani army of kill and dump policy against the political activists in Balochistan.

Under the kill and dump policy, Pakistani army has killed hundreds of thousands of Baloch political activists to curb the nationalist struggle being spread all over Balochistan. Spreading the organizational aims and objectives and making mass awareness in the Bolan and Mach areas regarding the ongoing Baloch struggle for the liberation of Baloch land and highlighting the state crimes being practiced in Balochistan were important roles he had played in a very short period of time. He was one of the important leaders of the Organization. His killing was a blow to the Organization but his commitment to the Baloch movement stood till his martyrdom. BSO AZAD pays tribute to their leaders for sacrificing their life in the line of freedom and vowed to continue their mission until independence Balochistan.

FAREED BALOCH

Fareed Baloch son of Haleem Baloch got birth on October 15 1989, in Panjgur. He was a resident of Civil Colony Khuzdar. Fareed Baloch was abducted outside the check post of Frontier Corps (FC) at Saryab road Quetta by the security agencies. On February 9, after 6 PM, when he was travelling with his cousin in a three-wheeler, he was stopped at the check point by the FC persons along with some persons who were in plain clothes and taken away in a jeep bearing no registration number.

He was a student of Balochistan University of Engineering and Technology Khuzdar and zonal president of the Baloch Students Organization Azad. After 45 days of abduction and torture in the army's cell, on 27 March his bullet riddled body was found at Ferozabad nullah of Khuzdar District Balochistan. Fareed was shot in the head and his body was also bore torture marks. He was

killed because of his political beliefs and was targeted for his exercise of peaceful political expression. Fareed had a dream of completing his education and working for the bright future of his people, but the army only killed him because of the ideology and political struggle he was doing for his people. He was a mature political leader who led the Organization in his zone in the very hard circumstances and a keen interest for reading books on different topics.

Tariq Baloch son of Mohammad Ashraf got birth on September 12 1993, in district Mastung. He was a resident of Mastung. He was a student of MBBS in Khyber Medical Collage, Peshawar, and president of BSO Azad Peshawar Zone. He had a key role in mobilizing Baloch students and uniting them on the signal platform in areas like Peshawar.

He was abducted because of his political beliefs and mobilization of Baloch youth regarding their basic rights, education and freedom. He, like other activities of BSO Azad, was abducted and extremely tortured by the security agencies of the Pakistani state. Likewise, he had a keen interest in study. Because of his love in this regard, he was able to get admission in MMBS in Khyber Medical Collage. But the state did not let him complete his study. Recognizing his national responsibility and pursuing his medical degree, he also engaged himself in political activities under the banner of Baloch Students

Organization Azad. He believed in political struggle and was targeted for his exercise of peaceful political expression.

On August 18, 2011, he was abducted by Pakistan's secret agencies in Quetta. His bullet-riddled body was found from Ganjadori, Mastung, on August 18, 2011.

Haneef Baloch s/o Shambe Baloch got birth in 1989 in Pasni, district Gwadar. He was a student of intermediate in Inter Collage Pasni, and was tasked as the president of BSO Azad Pasni Zone. He believed in political struggle and was targeted for his exercise of peaceful political expression. On July 4, 2011, he was abducted from Hub Chowki by Pakistan's secret agencies. In his early age, he got involved in the struggle of Baloch National liberation under the umbrella of Baloch Students Organization Azad.

He played an important role in mobilization the youth of Pasni by making them join the Organization. He was involved in each and every activity of the Organization by doing wall-chalking, distributing pamphlets and books and other literature of the Organization. After two days of extreme torture, his bullet-riddled and dumped body was found from Chakoli, Pasni, situated on Coastal Highway on July 6, 2011. Haneef was

shot in head and chest besides his body that bore deep wounds of torture in custody. He was killed under the Pakistani state's kill and dumped policy. His sacrifices for the greater cause of Baloch nation will be remembered until the end of the history.

Sher Zaman Kurd, 22 years old, was a resident of Mach, district Bolan. He was a student of M.A in University of Balochistan and president of BSO Azad Mach Zone. He believed in political struggle and was targeted for his exercise of peaceful political expression. On February 16, 2011, he was abducted in Kulpur district Mastung, by Pakistan's secret agencies. For three weeks, he was in the custody of the state agencies who extremely tortured him for the 'crime' of being sincere to his nation and working for the Baloch students' rights.

He was an active and hardworking activist of the Organization and had played a key role in organizing the organization activities in the areas like Mach . His abduction was ensured after the state agencies initiated a crackdown against the educated youth of Baloch nation, specifically the students who belonged to Baloch Students Organization Azad. He was pursuing a degree

in Balochistan University and had a keen interest in reading revolutionary literature.

Nearly a month after his abduction, his bullet-riddled body was found from Eastern Bypass Quetta on March 12, 2011. He will be remembered in golden words by in the history of Baloch nation for the remarkable struggle he did for the national liberation of Balochistan.

Asim Kareem s/o Haji Kareem got birth on October 16 1990, in Basima, district Washuk. He was a resident of Basima and was the brother of Martyr Tariq Kareem and Saqib Kareem. He was a diploma student in Electrical Engineering in Multan and president of BSO AZAD Multan Zone. He had played a key role in organizing Baloch youth under the single umbrella in a place like Multan. He was studying at Multan Polytechnic College.

On 26 October, he held a press conference at Quetta press club against the abduction of his brother Tariq Karim Baloch from Karachi. On 30 October, he was returning home after attending a wedding ceremony when the Pakistani security force fired live rounds at him and arrested him in injured condition. He was never heard of until 1 November 2010 when his dead body was discovered in Khanozai region in Balochistan. Calling of Asim Kareem was part of the State brutal polices were imposed for silencing BSO

Azad's activities to create fear among the Baloch youth regarding their political activities.

Asim Kareem was a hardworking student in the Organization. He had played an important role in engaging Baloch students in Punjab for their national role. He was killed for exercising his basic political rights. His bullet-riddled body was found from Khanozai, district Pishin. The blood of Asim will bring freedom for Balochistan.

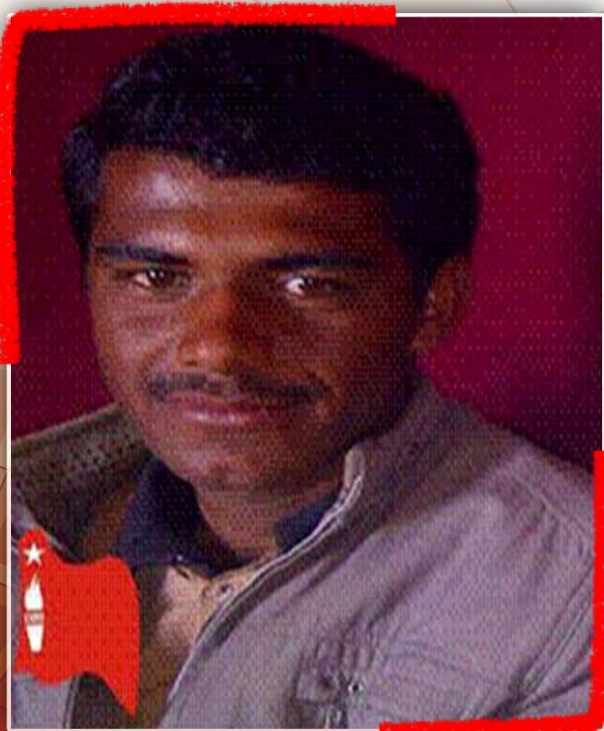
JAVED AKHTAR

Javed Akhtar s/o Master Akhtar Baloch got birth in December, 1983, at Buleda of district Kech. Javed Akhtar was a student of intermediate and B.A at Atta Shad Degree College Turbat and president of BSO Azad Buleda Zone. He believed in political struggle and was targeted for his exercise of peaceful political expression. He was killed by Pakistan army in a public gathering in Buleda on August 27, 2011. The gathering was arranged by BSO Azad's activists and other Baloch youth in reaction of killing Baloch elder leader Nawab Akbar Bugti. He was targeted by the security forces in front of hundreds of people after which he was shifted to Karachi for treatment. But he could not survive.

He was a hard-working member of the organization and played an important role in organization the Baloch youth under the banner of BSO Azad in his area. In his early age, he joined BSO Azad and started participating in each and every activity of the Organization. He

was killed because of the ‘crime’ of being a Baloch youth who spoke for the lawful demand of freedom for his motherland and for being a member of Baloch Students Organization Azad. Organization pays him highest tribute for the contributions he made in the struggle for the freedom of Baloch Homeland.

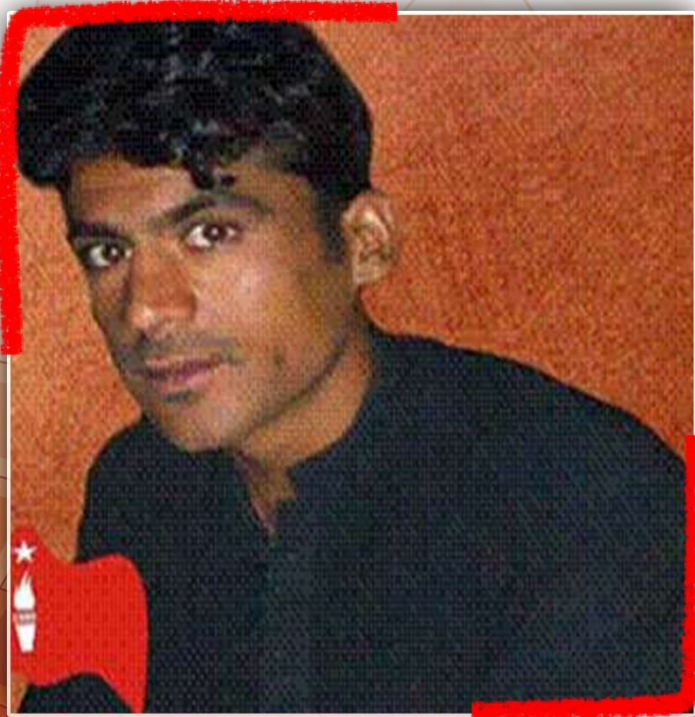
HASIL BALOCH

Hasil Baloch was a student of intermediate at Inter College Awaran and president of BSO Azad Mashkai zone. He had played an important role in organizing the political activities of the organization in Mashkai region. He was a devoted worker for the Organization and had a keen interest in reading revolutionary literature.

In his presidency, the organization had maintained to continue the struggle in Mashkai after a brutal crackdown against the Organization by the security agencies. The brutalities of the state did not allow him to continue his education as the Pakistani security forces went around him for his peaceful struggle under the banner of BSO Azad. He believed in political Struggle and was targeted for his exercise of peaceful political expression. He was killed by Pakistan army in a military operation in Kolwa, district Awaran, on

October 5, 2016. His sacrifices will be remembered in golden words in the chapter of BSO Azad and Baloch liberation movement.

He had served on different positions of the Organization and was elected as the President of the Naal Zone at a time when the organizational activities were banned throughout Balochistan and the members were facing a crackdown by the Pakistani army for being activists of BSO Azad and struggling for the people of Baloch homeland.

He believed in political struggle and was targeted for his exercise of peaceful political

expression. He was killed at his home by Pakistan army in Gresha on September 18, 2015. Like other cadre, he had also played an important role in expanding the organizational activities in his region. His sacrifices for the bright future of Baloch homeland will be remembered and the struggle for the restoration of Independence of Baloch homeland will undoubtedly continue.

Naeem Baloch was born on 8 May 1992 in Tootak and did his matriculation in his hometown. He completed his matriculation in 2008. He was doing his FSC in Degree College Khuzdar when he was killed by Pakistan army on 18 February 2011. He had also a passion of playing cricket but due to his political activities he did not get much time to spend on the sports. He had a keen interest of resolving the issues of the masses.

He joined BSO Azad in 2006. He was involved in each and every activity of the organization. He was threatened by the Pakistani security agencies and the local death squad leader to stop participating against the Pakistani army's crimes but he did not stop his peaceful and rightful political activism owing to such threats to his life. Due to his commitment and political attitude, he was elected as the deputy organizer of the Khuzdar zone. As an active

member of the Organization, he had given his all time to the organizational activities.

Before he was killed, he was arrested two times by the security forces to threat him for his political activism: once in 2009 when he was returning from Naal after a successful gathering of BSO Azad and the second time in 2010 with six other friends. Both the times, he was tortured in an extreme level but all such barbaric acts did not stop him from doing his politics for the national cause of Baloch nation. His commitment to the Organization was enhancing the Organizational agendas greatly and he did his all best to protect the Organizational and national interests first. For this, he lads down his life. His abduction and extreme torture strengthened his commitment to work more for the bright future of the nation.



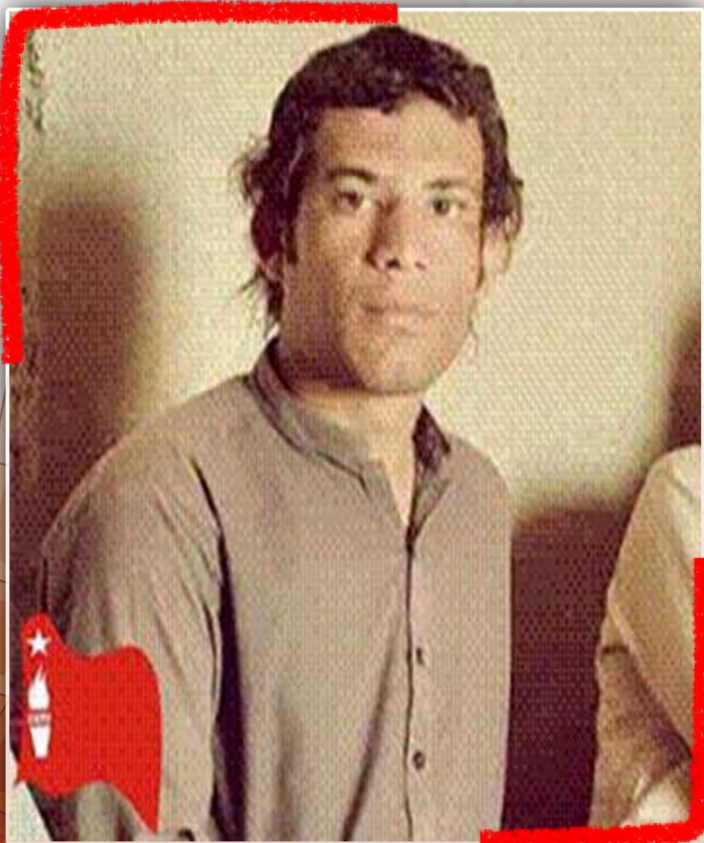

Rasool Jan Baloch s/o Dil Murad Baloch got birth on July 22, 1993 in Kolwa, district Awaran. Rasool Jan Baloch was a student of B.A at Atta Shad Degree College Turbat, Kech, and General Secretary of BSO Azad Turbat zone. He joined BSO Azad in 2008 when he was a student in Geshkor High School. He was also a teacher of Dynamic English Language Teaching Academy (DELTA). He was among the influential characters of student politics who had played an important role in organizing the activities of the Organization at a very difficult situation. He was keen to read literature and bring hundreds of students from his hometown to Kech for studying. He believed in political struggle and was targeted for his exercise of peaceful political expression. He was an intellectual and educated man who spread the awareness regarding national struggle and scientific education for which he was ordered to be abducted by the security agencies.

On January 6, 2014, he was abducted by Pakistan 's secret agencies from Turbat along with multiple other students. On April 13, 2015, he was killed in a fake encounter by Pakistan Army in Gebun Turbat along with five other detained Baloch prisoners. Rasool Jan was a strong character in the national movement's organizational platform. His body was marked with extreme signs of torture. He was among the committed members of the Organization and continued his struggle in the difficult times. He inspired many youths to join the caravan of BSO Azad. His sacrifices for the independence of the Baloch homeland at his youngest age will be remembered in the golden words in the chapters of Baloch history. His sacrifices will bring freedom to Baloch Homeland.

Kumar Baloch s/o Muhammad Ishaq got birth on February 5, 1996 in Kohrdo Jao, district Awaran. Kumar Baloch got his early education from Government High School Kohrdo Jao. Due to financial issues and his activities in the national struggle, he did not get much time to continue his study at the university level. After doing FA, he did a private BA but could not continue his education due to the condition mentioned above. He was a keen lover of education and a person of kindness. Unfortunately, the financial issues did not let him continue his higher education. He used to remain silent in most of the time. In his free time, Kumar Baloch played cricket in the village as he loved cricket in the field of sport while he also took part in the social activities in the village. He was always available to support the person who needed his help.

Kumar Baloch commenced his political career on the platform of BSO Azad in 2009 and till his martyrdom he was a part of Baloch Students Organization performing on different positions of the Organization. When he got martyrdom at the hands of the Pakistani state, he was serving as the organiser of the Jao Zone. He believed in political struggle and was targeted for his exercise of peaceful political expression. He was killed by Pakistani-backed religious extremists in Korak Jao, Awaran, on October 23, 2016. His sacrifices for the national liberation movement will always be remembered and he will continue to guide Baloch youth to join liberation struggle which is the only guarantor for a prosperous Balochistan.

He was also a keen lover of cricket and played cricket a lot in his free time from school and other activities. He always played cricket with other children of the area.

He became a formal member of the Organization in 2006 in the Mashkai Zone. He was one of the active members who took participation in each and every activity of the

Organization by doing pamphleteering, wall chalking, distribution of the magazines of the Organization and other activities. He performed on disparate positions of the Organization as being Unit Secretary, Deputy Unit Secretary and Vice President of Mashkai Zone. He was the Information Sectary of BSO AZAD Shaal Zone. He had a keen interest in studying computer and had high skills in computer. He was not let by the security forces to further continue his education as he was considered to be a threat because of his education and skills.

He played an important role in organizing the organizational activities in the capital city of Balochistan, Quetta. His family has been under the radar of the Pakistani army and its backed death squad in Pedraak. More than six members of his family have been killed by the security forces and their local militia to stop the national struggle being spread in the area. He was a polite political activist and keen observer of politics. He joined each and every activity of the

Organization to pursue the greater cause for the oppressed Baloch nation. He believed in political struggle and was targeted for his exercise of peaceful political expressions. He was a victim of willful killing along with his father and brother on 22 March 2014 at his home in a military operation by Pakistan's army in Pedraak district Kech, Balochistan. His body was marked with extreme signs of torture.

He was among the committed members of the Organization and continued his struggle in the difficult times. He inspired many youths to join the caravan of BSO Azad. His sacrifices for the independence of the Baloch homeland at his youngest age will be remembered in the golden words in the chapters of Baloch history. He was among the committed members of the Organization and continued his struggle in the difficult times. He inspired many youths to join the caravan of BSO Azad. His sacrifices for the independence of the Baloch homeland at his youngest age will be remembered in the golden words in the chapters of Baloch history. His sacrifices will bring freedom to Baloch Homeland.

Faraz Ulfat s/o Ulfath Naseem was a resident of Hub Chowki district Lasbela, Balochistan. Faraz Naseem was a former member of the Central Committee of Baloch Students Organization Azad and belonged to a political family. He was highly educated and took part in the political activities in a time when the state had continued the policy of killing Baloch political activists in fake encounters. He was a sincere political activist who played his part of role in the struggle of Baloch National Liberation Movement. He believed in political struggle and was targeted for his peaceful political expression.

He was abducted on 9th October 2011 by Pakistan's Intelligence Agency personnel from Hub town of Lasbela, Balochistan. After 24 days of detention and torture in the dungeon, his bullet riddled body was found dumped on 02 November, 2011 in Hub district Lasbela,

Balochistan. Extreme signs of torture and gunshot wounds were visible on victim's body. On 30th of October in a press conference outside Quetta press Club, the sister of Faraz Baloch said, "The families fear that their loved ones might just be killed and dumped like hundreds of other Baloch activists who have recently been tortured to death by Pakistani security force while in their custody." He was the victim of the Pakistan Army's kill and dumped policy against Baloch political activists. His body was marked with extreme signs of torture.

He was among the committed members of the Organization and continued his struggle in the difficult times. He inspired many youths to join the caravan of BSO Azad. His sacrifices for the independence of the Baloch homeland at his youngest age will be remembered in the golden words in the chapters of Baloch history. His sacrifices will bring freedom to Baloch Homeland.

Yayha Jan got his early education at Government Model High School Khuzdar. He was pursuing FSC when he was martyred by the Pakistani army. He was martyred on 18th February, 2011. He was a very silent person by nature and most of the time remained alone in his life. Due to financial issues, Yahya Jan started working in a retail shop at a minor age. He lost one of his eyes and a hand when the thieves attacked him while he was in the shop, which caused serious pain to him in the very young age. He was also a fan of cricket and played the game in his early age. After the martyrdom, a cricket club was named in the area as Shaheed Yahya Cricket Club which is still present in Khuzdar.

He started his political career on the platform of Baloch Students Organization Azad in 2006. He performed on deferent positions in Zonal level of the Organization. He was

performing as a Zonal member during his time of martyrdom. He was forbidden by the family for his political activities in the organization as BSO Azad was in the radar of the state brutalities and kill and dump policy, but he remained very committed to the Baloch cause until he was kidnapped by the Pakistani agencies and killed like thousands of other political activists. He took part in multiple activities of the organization like wall chalking, protesting and pamphlet distribution and other activities of the organization. He was once arrested by police during an organizational activity in Khuzdar with six other friends but after 2 months they were released. Later on, once again he was abducted and, then, martyred by the Pakistani army. His remarkable struggle for the independence of Baloch Nation will always be remembered in the golden words.

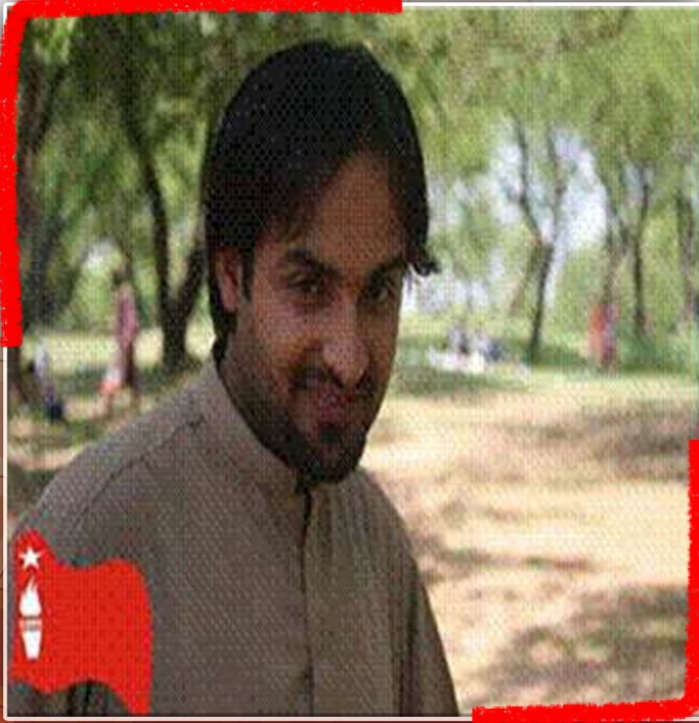
TARIQ KAREEM

Tariq Kareem was whisked away by the Pakistani intelligence agencies from Al-Rauf Royal City, Block 19, Flat no. C-614, Gulistan-e-Johar Karachi on 21st October with two other friends. His bullet-riddled body was found dumped on 11 May, 2012, in Eastern Bypass Quetta, Balochistan. Two other of his brothers Saqib Kareem and Asim Kareem were also killed by the Pakistani security forces in different occasion. Tariq Kareem played a key role in expanding Baloch liberation movement, particularly Baloch Students Organization Azad in his hometown, Basima. He mobilized hundreds of Baloch youth to join BSO Azad and

Baloch liberation movement. He performed duties on different position of the organization and was elected as the Zonal president soon after the organizational General Body in Basima. He was the first in his region to spread awareness regarding Baloch liberation movement. Due to his day and night struggle, hundreds of youth from his region joined Baloch liberation movement. He is considered to be a pioneer of Baloch Movement. Organization pays him richest tribute and will continue his struggle until the Freedom of Baloch homeland.

On 13th August, 2016, security forces handed over three dead bodies to Civil Hospital Quetta, Balochistan. Security forces bluntly lied and claimed to kill him in an encounter while he was in their custody for a

long time. From there, the fake encounters of Baloch youth has been continued from the Pakistani security forces. His family has always been targeted by the security agencies for their political belonging to Baloch political Organization. His sacrifices for the future of their people will not go in vain and the Baloch homeland will witness freedom sooner or later.

His bullet-riddled body was found dumped on 18th of January, 2011, in GanjiDoori district Mastung, Balochistan. He was killed for exercising his political views and right to politics for their people. He took participation in each and every

activity of the Organization and played a key role in mobilizing the youth of the area for the revolution.

He joined BSO Azad in a very young age and martyred by the Pakistan Army in a very young age after severe torture. His body was marked with extreme signs of torture. He was among the committed members of the Organization and continued his struggle in the difficult times. He inspired a lot of youths to join the caravan of BSO Azad. His sacrifices for the independence of the Baloch homeland at his youngest age will be remembered in the golden words in the chapters of Baloch history. 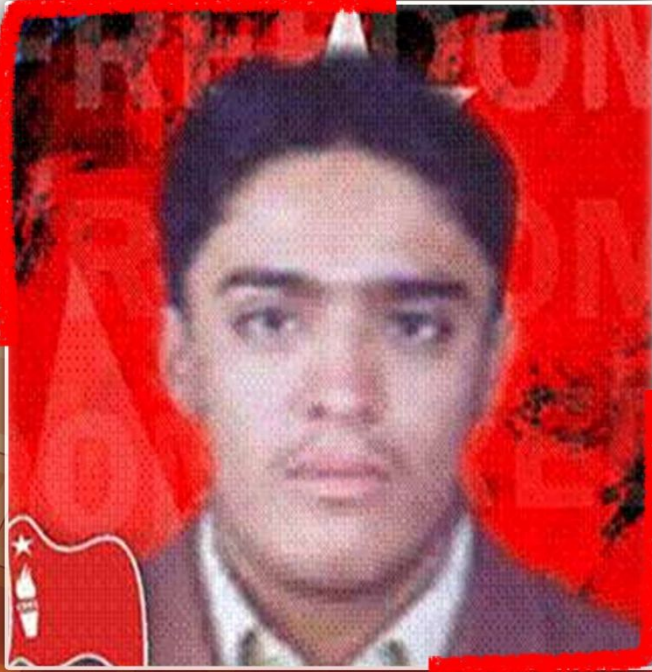
SHAHNAWAZ BALOCH

The first Balochi language children's monthly Magazine 'Darwant' which remained in circulation for two years till his involuntary disappearance by Pakistani state, was the vision and efforts of this young Baloch journalist. Mystic soul, secular mind made him visit

Church, Temple and Mosque and do medication late nights in search of his creator. In Quetta as a BSO Azad activist, he frequently visited Voice for Baloch Missing Persons' (VBMP) camp at Quetta Press Club. On 21 December, 2010, while en route to Turbat from Quetta, he was forced to disembark from a bus at Badok check post on Coastal Highway by Pakistani state intelligence agencies and became one among thousands of Baloch activists to have been forcibly disappeared by Pakistan. After 2 weeks on 5 January, 2011 Ilyas Nizar Baloch's tortured body with four bullet-wounds was found with another fellow of BSO Azad and activist Qambar Chakar in Pedrak. His body was marked with extreme signs of torture. He was among the committed members of the Organization and continued his struggle in the difficult times. He inspired many youths to join the caravan of BSO Azad. His sacrifices for the independence of the Baloch homeland at his youngest age will be remembered in the golden words in the chapters of Baloch history. His sacrifices will bring freedom to Baloch Homeland.

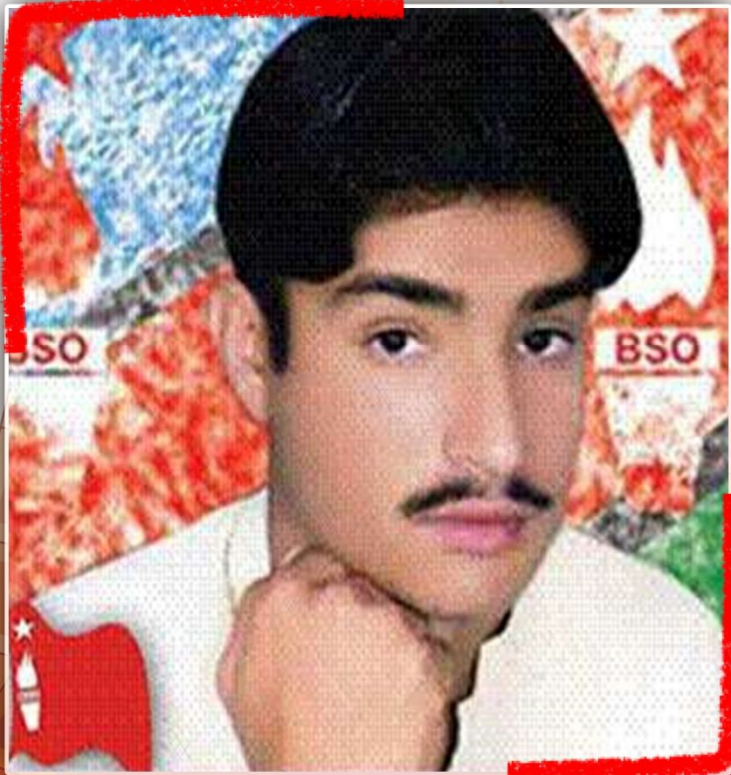
WAHEED BALOCH

and Ghulam Ullah Baloch were found in Khuzdar district of Balochistan. His body was marked with extreme signs of torture. He was among the committed members of the Organization and continued his struggle in the difficult times. Because of him plenty of youths were inspired to join the caravan of BSO Azad. His sacrifices for the independence of the Baloch homeland at his youngest age will be remembered until a single Baloch remains on the earth. His only dream was the independence of Baloch homeland.

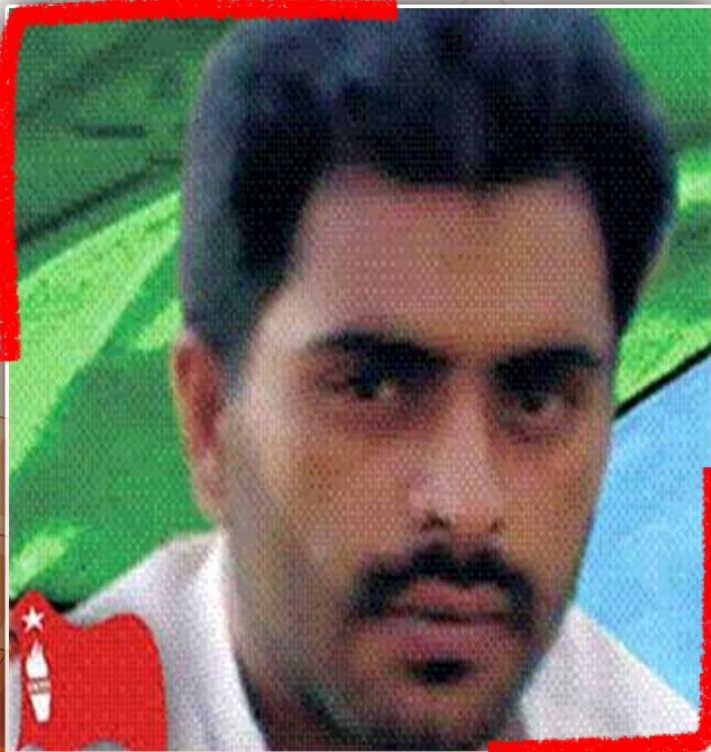
KALEEM BALOCH

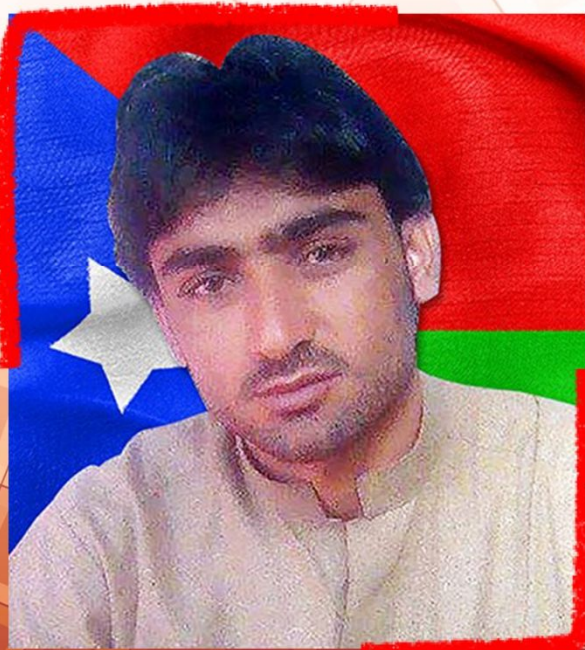
MAQSOOD QALANDARANI

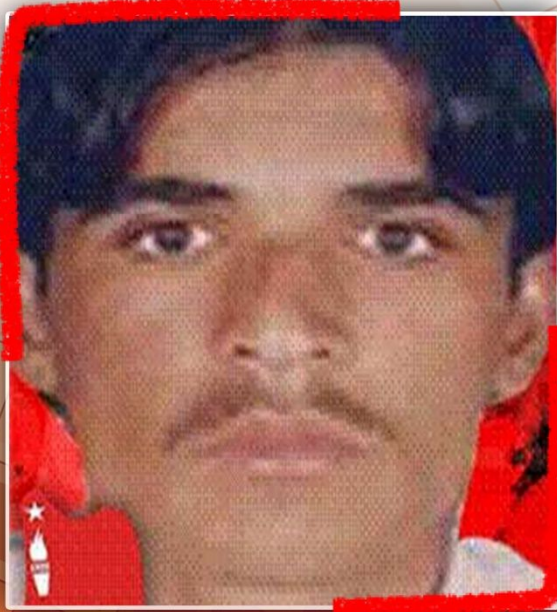

Due to financial problems, he worked as a tailor and also a student of F.A in Inter College Pasni. He joined BSO Azad in his early age to work for the national cause under the banner of organization. He was a member of BSO Azad Pasni zone. He was a very active member of the organization because of his activism on December 22, 2010, he was abducted by Pakistan's secret agencies in Karwat Makuran Coastal Highway along with a journalist belonging to Human Rights Commission of Pakistan, Sadiq. After four months of torture and detention in the torture cells of the Pakistan army, his bullet-riddled body along with Sadiq was found from Geri Sarbat Coastal Highway, district Gwadar, on May 28, 2011. Both victims were shouted in the head and chest. Their bodies bore multiple torture marks. His

family registered a case in the police against FC and security agencies while they held a token hunger strike in front of Pasni Press Club right after his abduction but still he was killed extra judicially by the Pakistani army. He was among the committed members of the organization and continued his struggle in the difficult times. He was a source of inspiration for too many other youths to join the caravan of BSO Azad. His sacrifices for the independence of the Baloch homeland at his youngest age will be remembered with the golden words in the history of Baloch resistance. His sacrifices will bring freedom to Baloch Homeland.

Zakriya Zehri s/o Ali Dost Zehri belonged to Anjeera of Khuzdar. He got his early education from his native town of Anjeera. For some times, he also studied Islamic education from the Madrassah of his town. He got his middle and matric education from Madrassah Taaleem-ul-Islam and Tablighi College Hub. After doing his matric, he was enrolled in Poly Technical Collage Quetta to get a diploma in the field of Civil Engineering. He started his political career from Gul Bahar Unit of BSO Azad in Khuzdar in 2009 while there was a surge in the activism of BSO Azad in the area. After going to Shaal for his educational career, he got membership in the Poly Technical Unit of BSO Azad Shaal zone.

He was on his way to Shaal for his exams when he was abducted by the law enforcement agencies on 11th of December, of 2010. His mutilated dead body was thrown by the security

agencies in Sorab on 15 January of 2011. His body was marked with extreme signs of torture. His family was targeted by the state-backed Sardar of the area and they wanted to capture their land but family of Martyred Zakriya resisted against the oppression of the tribal chiefs and did not let them to occupy on their land. One of his cousins, Yaseen, was also martyred by Pakistani army as being the member of the organization.
